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OF

VILLAGE PROPERTY OWNER'S ASSOCIATION OF

POTESKEET VILLAGE SUBDIVISION, INC.

I, the undersigned natural person of the age of eighteen years or more, acting as incorporator for the purpose of creating a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of North Carolina, as contained in Chapter 55 A of the General Statutes of North Carolina, entitled "Non-Profit Corporation Act", and the several amendments thereto, do hereby set forth:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the Corporation is Village Property Owner's Association of Poteskeet Village Subdivision, Inc.

ARTICLE TWO

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- (a) To promote cooperation in all matters of interest to the property owners in the community, and to aid and protect its members and to do all things as are properly within the scope of such an association for the welfare of its members and the community.
- (b) To have and exercise all powers, rights and privileges, conferred on corportions by the laws of the State of North Carolina, in particular Chapter 55 A, and all rights and powers incidental in carrying out the purposes for which this corporation is formed, except those which are inconsistent with the express provisions of the act under which this corporation is formed.
- (c) To foster and advance matters deemed to be in the best interest of the members of the Association.
- (d) To assist in establishing and maintaining high community standards and to take whatever action is necessary and advisable in these respects.
- (e) To make charges and collect dues in the manners and ways and in accord with the provisions of the By-laws of the Association and for the uses and purposes hereinabove set forth.
- (f) To employ such person or persons the Board of Directors may deem necessary to accomplish the purposes hereinabove set forth.
- (g) To admit members in accordance with the By-laws of the $\ensuremath{\mathsf{Associ}}$ ation.

ARTICLE FOUR

Directors of the corporation shall be elected in the following manner:

Directors shall be elected by the members of the Association at its first regular meeting as provided in the By-laws.

ARTICLE FIVE

The address for the initial rec ered office of the corporation is:

ARTICLE SIX

The number of the Directors of the Association may be fixed by the By-laws, but shall not be less than three.

The number of Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors shall be three, and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first meeting of the Association or until their successors are duly elected and qualified are:

ARTICLE SEVEN

ARTICLE EIGHT

In addition to the powers granted corporations under the laws of the State of North Carolina, this Association shall have full power and authority to:

- (a) Admit members who are property owners in Poteskeet Village Subdivision, Village of Duck, Atlantic Township, Dare County, North Carolina in accordance with the By-laws duly adopted by this Association.
- (b) The Board of Directors of the Association shall have full power by vote of the majority of all the Directors and without the consent or vote of the members of the Association to make, alter, amend, or rescind the By-laws of this corporation.

ARTICLE NINE

This corporation shall not engage in any business, trade, avocation, or profession for pecuniary gain or profit nor shall it have any power to issue certificates of stock or declare dividends, and no part of its net earnings or assets shall inure to the benefit of any member, director, or individual except those to be derived from the activities and purposes for which this corporation was formed. The balance, if any, of all funds and monies received by the corporation from its operation or any other source, after the payment of all debts and obligations of the corporation and the Association of whatever kind and natures, shall be used and distributed exclusively for charitable, scientific, governmental, or educational purposes pursuant to a plan of distribution which shall be adopted by the members of the corporation upon the dissolution or liquidation thereof, and which shall be in accord with the appropriate revenue provisions of the Internal Revenue Service of the United States and the Department of Revenue of the State of North Carolina.

ARTICLE TEN

Membership in this Association shall not be transferable except and in accord with the terms of the By-laws.

ARTICLE ELEVEN

No member who has died, resiged, or otherwise ceased to be a member of the Association shall thereafter have any interest in or claim upon any assets of the Association.

ARTICLE TWELVE

No subdivision developer except if they are property owners as defined in the By-laws, shall be eligible for membership in this Association. Only members who are owners of lots which have passed from the control of any subdivision developer shall be eligible to vote on matters coming under the jurisdiction of the Association. For purposes of this article, lots which are being purchased under land contracts (conditional sales contracts) shall be deemed to have passed from the control of any subdivision developer.

ARTICLE THIRTEEN

The Association may, subject to the approval of its Board of Directors and of its members as provided by its By-laws, merge or consolidate with other associations.
